The Wind Doesn't Have a Plan: Miami Dade College's (MDC) Art Gallery System, in collaboration with Galleria Ca' d'Oro and the Brickellian.

Blue and Joy is the brainchild of Fabio La Fauci and Daniele Sigalot. Through the adventures of two characters, Blue and Joy, the Italian artists explore emotions beneath the surface. *Blue*, despite his tears and broken heart, is the happiest creature on earth. In contrast, *Joy* wears an eternal smile, but is the saddest being in the world.

Curated by Gloria Porcella, Lamberto Petrecca and Stella Holmes, the art work blends painting, sculpture, mosaic, photography and digital media. In addition, the Freedom Tower will showcase smaller versions of the artists' large paper planes sculpted in aluminum, which will be displayed along Brickell Avenue during Art Basel.

Blue and Joy have appeared in exhibitions worldwide as well as books documenting their adventures. Prior to opening their first *Blue and Joy* studio in 2008, La Fauci and Sigalot worked in the advertising industry.

The wind doesn't have a plan, free and open to the public, runs through Dec.
