

VIBRANT ART IN MOTION at Miami Dade College

The most prolific site of public art in Downtown Miami, Miami Dade College's Wolfson Campus houses an impressive array of large-scale sculptures by notable artists. This season, in addition to its permanent collection, it is home to *Original Sin*, a vibrantly hued, kinetic sculpture by Italian artist **Camilla Ancilotto** that draws on imagery past and present.

On loan from **Galleria Ca d'Oro**, the work is made up of geometric parts that each rotate. On one side, the shapes collectively reproduce Michelangelo's Sistine Chapel panel *The Expulsion From Paradise*, as well as details from works by Renaissance masters Bronzino and Titian, while other parts make contemporary references to James Cameron's *Avatar* and President Obama. The sculpture's interactive nature draws students, faculty and visitors to reconfigure and redefine it with every touch.
