

Foreverglades: Cracking Art Group's Art Basel Exhibit On and In Miami Freedom Tower (VIDEO, PHOTOS)



The Gator in the Bay won't be the only cold-blooded attraction turning heads this Art Basel season. Galleria Ca' d'Oro and Cracking Art Group, the collective behind the pepto pink snails on Miami Beach in 2010, have adorned Miami's Freedom Tower with primary-colored resin creatures. Installed Friday and running through December 9, the historic building will be covered with alligators, salamanders, and frogs as well as house 300 more critters inside for an exhibit called "Foreverglades." The reptilian pieces, some measuring nearly 20 feet long, are the work of William Sweetlove, who has also infiltrated cities like Siracusa, Milan, Rome, Venice with his resin animals.
